(Additional sanitizer to be available on site if required) Anyone showing signs of symptoms on arrival will be refused entry. Any player showing signs in the day will withdrawn and isolated and expected to be collected by a parent. Where possible, social distancing of 2m to be encouraged whilst on site. Toilet facility restricted to limited use of one person (the exception being family or household groups/bubbles). Competitive Training through Matches may now be permitted and from the 1st of August competitive matches, providing social distancing is in place before and after the match, and in any breaks in play. Social distancing is only relaxed during play – at all other times before, during and after training social distancing rules remain the same – 2 metres. When the ball goes out of play, it should not be retrieved by non - participants and should be retrieved using the feet rather than the hands where possible. Goal celebrations should be discouraged. Coaches to limit persistent close proximity of participants during match play and training. Participants must not spit and should avoid shouting or raising their voices when facing each other. Children will be encouraged not to touch any of the equipment (cones, poles etc). Children should avoid handling the footballs, unless they are a goalkeeper who must wear their own gloves and not share any gloves with other children. Children should not share bibs, shin pads or any other form of clothing or kit. Each child must have their own, clearly labelled, drinks container. FIRST AID – To be available per coach/bubble with first aid only to be administered if absolutely necessary.
